## Enterprise Singapore calls for public comment on Singapore standards

Members of the public are invited to provide feedback on draft Singapore Standards for publication and work item proposals for development and review of Singapore Standards and Technical References.

### A) Notification of Draft Singapore Standards for Publication

Members of the public are invited to comment on the following Singapore Standard documents:

1. Chemical – water-based enamel paint, water-based primer for metal and wood, hazardous waste management
2. Electrical and Electronic – emergency voice communication systems in buildings, passenger and goods lifts
3. Environment and Resources – compressed air, aluminium sulphate
4. Quality and Safety – sport safety, tower cranes (3 standards)

### B) Notification of Proposal for the Review of Standards

Members of the public are invited to comment on the Environment and Resources – rotating electrical machines (2 standards).

The reviews are ongoing and the new versions/drafts are not available at this juncture. Users can refer to the current standards to provide feedback.
